Why do I need to use an accredited local Funeral Home?

Who is in charge of making funeral arrangements?

The executor of the estate is in control, they override all family members but may choose to appoint a family member to arrange the funeral.

Will Centrelink or DVA help?

By rule of thumb they will provide 7 fortnightly pays to the spouse of a pensioner or someone receiving a carers payment (not allowance).
